SPRING



- For the farmer, a season of PLANTING
- For the disciple, a season of HOPE
- Time of rebirth, renewal, and resurrection
- Daylight increases // Hope rises



WINTER



- For the farmer, a season of REST
- For the disciple, a season of TRUST
- Time of harsh exteriors resulting in death or dormant life (i.e. trees, plants, seeds)
- dormant (adj): in a state of rest; alive but temporarily inactive
- Greatest darkness of the year // Hope dies

SUMMER



- For the farmer, a season of TENDING
- For the disciple, a season of FULFILLMENT
- Time of fruitfulness and thriving
- Greatest daylight of the year // Hope is actualized



FALL



- For the farmer, a season of HARVESTING
- For the disciple, a season of RESPONSIBILITY (thanksgiving &/or regret)
- Time of reaping what was sown in other seasons (good &/or bad)
- Daylight decreases // Hope fades



Ecclesiastes 3:1-8

Keys to Making the Most of Every Season:

- Understand seasons are a normal part of life
- Believe no season lasts forever
- Don't stay stuck in a season

- Embrace the proper season to avoid discouragement
- Realize some seasons last longer than others, but are necessary to equip you for what lies ahead
- Prepare for the next season while waiting
- Don't try to force your way into or out of a season. New seasons are directed by God - not us.
- Trust God to communicate His timing
